




### GRAND CRU RANGEN

Smokiness and the purest note of Amalfi lemon combine into an intriguing aroma on this wine's nose. The palate is a picture of concentrated, ripe lemon, buffered by stony austerity and channeled into the sinuous intensity. Right now this wine brims with youthful fruit, but it also has stony depth. 

### GRAND CRU KASTELBERG

This wine's nose is subtle but gently aromatic, with tangerine and a tropical overtone of passionfruit. On the palate the concentration becomes evident. Fruitiness, with zesty, ripe lemon uppermost, seems anchored in coolness, giving this wine a taut, linear and zesty outlook. If you are looking for refreshment, this is it. [ANNE KREBIEHL MW](#)



### GRAND CRU SOMMERBERG


Subtle hints of tangerine and summer blossom hit the nose before the aromas of this wine shut again. The palate, framed by lemon zestiness, presents the rounded ripeness of 2018, offering juicy peach with an earthy edge. Intense zestiness propels this wine forward to a dry, mouthwateringly fresh finish, ringing with lemon zestiness. [ANNE KREBIEHL MW](#)

### GRAND CRU ROSACKER

The subtle nose of this wine reveals precise, lifted lemon zest. That brightness fills out the streamlined palate with ripe peach but everything happens along that central freshness, yet fully ripe and energetic. The dry, racy finish has a touch of tangerine. [ANNE KREBIEHL MW](#)



### GRAND CRU SCHOENENBOURG

An initial, gentle whiff of green apple on this wine's nose is joined by riper notions of yellow fruit. On the palate the apple freshness is supported by some residual carbon dioxide and its subtle spritz. The fruit becomes rounder, showing notions of Mirabelle edged with lemony brightness and freshness. It's a beautifully proportioned, refined and elegant dry Riesling. [ANNE KREBIEHL MW](#)



### GRAND CRU BRAND

A smoky touch of reduction still clings to zesty citrus notions on this wine's nose. The citrus takes over the streamlined, fresh but ripe palate that tingles with lemon-peel intensity. Fresh but ripe, the long finish is alive with that lemon-peel note. [ANNE KREBIEHL MW](#)
